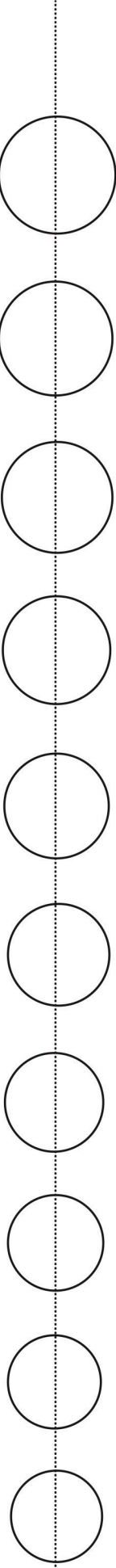




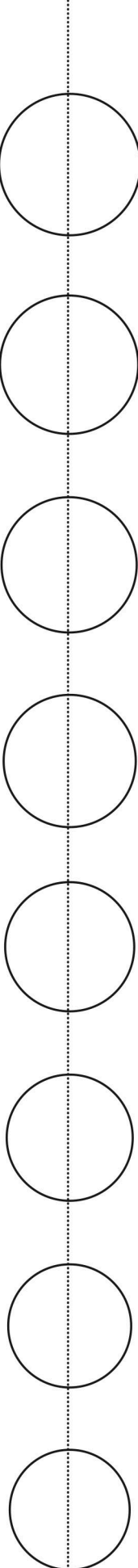
Template for determining your ring size

Explanation

To find your ring size, download the ring size template and print it out to scale on A4. It is best to check whether the specification of the diameter below the circle also corresponds to the diameter of your template. The number above the circle indicates the circumference in mm (= ring size). The number below the circle indicates the diameter. If you fold the paper along the dotted line, you can easily cut out a semicircle along the circular line. This creates a round cutout with which you can measure your ring size. Make sure that the cutout is firmly attached to the finger on which the ring is to be worn. The cutout may stretch slightly over the knuckle.
